\$500 Open Western Championship:

Points from class #'s 13, 23, 31, 39, 42, 49, & 50 will be used to determine Championship. Only same horse/rider teams will be eligible for consideration of prize money.

Championship will pay back as follows:

*\$250 to horse/rider team who scores the highest number of points
\$125 to horse/rider team who scores second highest number of points
\$75 to horse/rider team who scores third highest number of points
\$ 50 to horse/rider team who scores fourth highest number of points*

A minimum of 6 riders in 50% or more of the classes is required for full payback. If less than 6 riders in 50% or more of the classes payback will be determined by show management.
